



## Cornhole Tournament Rules:

- The Cornhole Boards: Should be placed on a flat surface 27 feet apart (front to front).
- The Cornhole Bags: There should be 8 bags, 4 bags of each color. Consisting of 2 teams.
- This is a single elimination tournament.
- 2 two player teams will face each other on opposite sides of the boards.
- The first throw will be determined by a coin toss. Throws will then be alternated until the bags are out. The winner of that round will throw first in the following round.
- The front end of the cornhole board is the foul line. If a player crosses the foul line, no points will be awarded for that throw and no re-throws will be permitted.
- The game will be played to 21, first player to reach 21 OR GO OVER 21 wins the match.
- The bag must land on the board or in the hole in order to count. No bags bounced or touching any other surface other than the board will be considered foul bags with no points awarded.
- All bags must remain untouched after thrown until the score has been determined by official.
- Each bag landing on the board is awarded 1 point. Each bag landing in the cornhole is awarded 3 points. If both opponents land in the cornhole or on the board, the points will cancel. Only the points after the cancellation will go towards the official score to 21.
- The scoring will be determined by official; however, players are recommended to pay close attention to scores. If the score is being called into question, what the official says goes.
- No timeouts will be permitted.
- Both players must check in the day of the event by 5:30 PM. Both players must be present, or a sub has to be provided.

- Brackets will be updated after each round. This is a 16 team tournament with one winner.
- As much as we encourage having a great time, we must keep good sportsmanship for a fun, successful tournament. Any player(s) who act in any conduct unsportsmanlike will be disqualified and will not be permitted to enter any other tournaments. Nothing but positive!
